Anagram Concentration

Directions: Print the cards onto cardstock. Cut the cards along the borderlines, shuffle them, and place them face down in rows. The first player turns over a card, and reads the word out loud. Next, he/she turns over a second card, and reads the word out loud. He/she decides if the two cards are anagram matches. If they match, the same player gets another turn. If the cards do not match, they are turned back over, and the next player takes a turn. The game continues until all of the cards have been matched. The player who accumulates the most matches is the winner.
